On November 2, 1996, the pastor and board members from North Webster Church of God came to the Michigan offices of **United Church Structures** to visit. February, 1997, Robert Arrendale started working drawings for the church; in October 1997, **UCS's** crew was on site assembling their 110' geodesic dome.

The church chose **UCS's** gable option to highlight a focal cross that can be viewed from the interior and exterior. The gable's pitched roof adds a custom touch and breaks up the roof line. The design features an 18' sidewall that gives additional height for the large balcony which wraps around the sanctuary. The new church is attached to the existing structures that are still used for offices and classrooms.
