In December, 1997, the crew of UCS assembled an 80' octagon for Ephesus Seventh Day Adventist Church of Saginaw, Michigan. This was not the first time we had worked with Pastor Blake of Ephesus Seventh Day Adventist. In 1992, UCS built two geodesic domes for Pastor Blake's former congregation in Marion, Indiana. One was a sanctuary; one a fellowship hall.

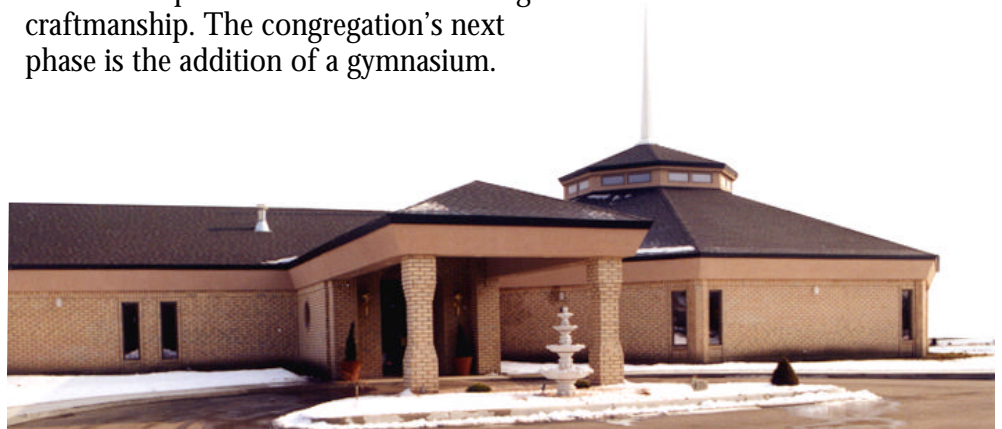
