In November 1992, St. Luke's Missionary Baptist Church started preliminary drawings with Robert Arrendale. Today, they have a beautiful new complex. Moving to a new site was easy because they moved just three miles from their original location.

The crew of United Church Structures assembled a 110' geodesic dome for the congregation. Its design featured an 18' sidewall that gave them height for the attached buildings and room for a large balcony. The wings house the church's fellowship hall, classrooms, offices, bathrooms, and mechanical rooms. St. Luke's is a perfect example of how a UCS building package can be customized to fit any congregation's needs.
