First Baptist of Middleville exemplifies how a UCS package can be modified to present a custom look.



UCS is proud of its second church project with builder, Jerry McMaster of McMaster Corp. The First Baptist Church of Middleville is an attractive structure partly because of the gables that give it its distinct exterior lines. These gables house the stairs to the lower level. This church is an excellent example of how a UCS package can be customized for a contemporary appearance.

The Middleville congregation choose an 88' Octagon (5,472 s.f.) for their new sanctuary which seats 400-450. The layout is very unique with an entrance located on the lower level and an entrance to the sanctuary on the first floor level. The sanctuary uses both natural and artificial lighting to accent the beautiful worship space.



For the exterior finish the church decided on a sandy colored brick. Above the entrance the brick is complemented by the white trim and embossed seal. By connecting their new structure to their existing facility they created an extensive complex with the square footage necessary to conduct numerous programs and activities. They wisely built two wings that are used for four classrooms and overflow seating.
